The Forerunner of Jesus

- Foretold by the prophets
 - Isiah 40:3-5 (Mt. 3:3 & Lk. 3:4-6)
 - Malachi 3:1; 4:5-6 (Mk 1:3 7 Lk 1:17)

Compare John with Jesus

- Supernatural Birth
 - Annunciation by an angel
 - Miracle of the particular birth (barren and virgin
 - Named Prophet of Most High
- Jesus "one-up" each stage
 - Virgin conception more miraculous
 - Jesus named "Son of the Most High

Unconventional John or New Eligiah

- No formal religious training a "nobody", named as a "voice in wilderness"
- Wore camel hair, ate wild honey and locust, drank no "strong drink (Nu 6:1-12 & Lev. 11"22-23)" = Did not dress to impress
- · Lived with Essenes shaped belief in purity and baptism by water

Dirty John with Admirable Character

- · Clothed in humility (Mk. 1:7, Lk. 3:15-16, Jn. 1:27)
- He claimed "NOT to be the Messiah" instead he was unworthy
- Competing Ministry with Jesus = Sent his own disciples to follow Jesus
- Gave up his life for God's Message

John's Ministry

- Confrontational
 - Repentance for dead works (Mt. 3:2-10
 - Confession
 - Restitution
 - Bearing Fruit from repentance
 - Forgiveness (Mk. 1:4)
 - Jesus as The Lamb of God (Jn. 1;29, 35-36), Son of God (Jn. 1;34), Bridegroom (Jn: 29),
 - Water Baptism (Mt. 3:6, Jn. 1:3)
 - Future baptism by H.S. (Mt. 3:11)
 - Warned the Jewish nation (Mt. 3:10-12)

Nazarite Vow

- Greatest of the all prophets
- The last prophet
- Transition from Old to New Covenant
- Nazarite Vow a life of self-denial. holiness (Jd. 16:17)
